Belgocontrol AIS is responsible for the publication and distribution of aeronautical information, both static (AIP) and dynamic (NOTAM) for Belgium and the G.D. of Luxembourg according to the requirements stated in Annex 15 to the ICAO Convention of Chicago. The ATS Reporting Office (ARO) is integrated in AIS. Our offices are situated in the Control Tower at the east side of the Brussels National Airport.



Our objectives

We are continuously striving for high quality aeronautical information through accuracy, integrity and timeliness of the data in order to guarantee the safety of air navigation. As an ISO 9001:2000 certified company, data are processed according to standard operational procedures and work instructions in order to monitor the data chain from origination by the providers until publication. Our products

AIP

The AIP of Belgium and the G.D. of Luxembourg is available in both paper and electronic (CD-ROM) format. Per year 13 amendments (AMDT) to this document are published according to the ICAO 28 days AIRAC cycle, a calendar with worldwide common dates on which aeronautical information shall become effective. Furthermore, we publish supplements (SUP) to the AIP and aeronautical information circulars (AIC).

Our team belongs to the pioneers in Europe who developed the electronic AIP (eAIP) with the XML technology according to Eurocontrol technical specifications. This achievement has been quite a challenge in aeronautical information management.

NOTAMs/SNOWTAMs

We publish NOTAMs for Brussels FIR and SNOWTAMs for the Belgian civil aerodromes and process international NOTAMs and SNOWTAMs. A list of valid NOTAM for Belgium and the G.D. of Luxembourg is available on our internet site or can be received via fax. The system for daily warnings provides the airspace user with a visual presentation of all special activities that take place in the Brussels FIR and which are notified by NOTAM.

Preflight Information Bulletin (PIB)

A PIB tailored to your needs can be obtained via fax or can be consulted via the internet.

MAP Selection

An up-to-date bulletin containing NOTAM and OPMET messages is provided by clicking on an aerodrome spot on the map of the Brussels FIR. During winter, SNOWTAM messages (for main airports only) are also included in the report.

Aerodrome and FIR Bulletin

An aerodrome and FIR bulletin provides NOTAM, SNOWTAM and OPMET information for all the FIRs and aerodromes selected in the request. Such type of bulletin is advised in the initial flight preparation phase in order to obtain information about the aerodrome

status and the availability of airspace and/or routes.

Narrow Route Bulletin

A Narrow Route Bulletin provides NOTAM, SNOWTAM and OPMET information strictly tailored to the needs of the pilot. Only NOTAMs that relate to the intended flight route are included.

Entering the callsign and the aerodrome of departure and destination of a valid flight plan will automatically produce a Narrow Route Bulletin for this flight.

If no flight plan has been filed, entering the complete flight route details, as well as the aerodrome of departure, arrival and the alternate aerodromes, will allow retrieving the same type of bulletin.

Flight planning

Flight plans can be submitted at the ARO by telephone, fax or AFTN, through a BNASC workstation (at international airports in Belgium) or via the internet. Belgocontrol has developed an electronic flight plan form for transmission via the internet. If the flight plan is submitted via the internet, the pilot must contact ARO to ensure the flight plan is received correctly and has been approved by the Air Traffic Services.

Our services

Selfbriefing stations at international airports in Belgium and the G.D. of Luxembourg

An integrated computer system, known as the BNASC system, assists the user for the input of flight plans, consultation of NOTAMs, SNOWTAMs and meteorological data/charts, and for the retrieval of preflight information bulletins.

These workstations are at the disposal of the crews, the air traffic controllers, the meteorological services and the airport authorities at all main airports.

On-line preflight briefing via the internet

Airspace users can file a flight plan and obtain preflight information via the Belgocontrol website (www.belgocontrol.be) after registration.

Library

International AIP, AIP Supplements and AIC of all European countries, of most countries in Africa and Asia, and some countries in North and South America, as well as regulatory publications (Belgian CAA, ICAO) are available for consultation.
